4.

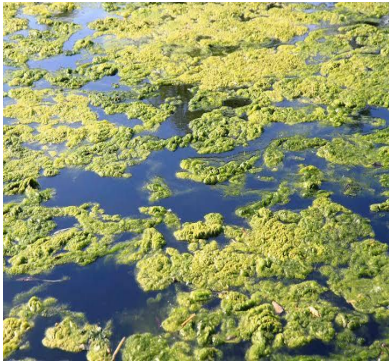
That weird smell outside? It's mold — not “just the weather.”
